TW – We patrol Golf Green Ward on a daily basis mostly looking for environmental issues as well as dealing with the public concerns.

The Junior Wardens scheme was successful as a pilot and if funding is available will be doing with this year's year 6 at Frobisher.

We (warden and councillors) have applied to get the one way system looked at with a view to removing as well possible re marking around the roundabout on Lotus Way/Brooklands and Tamarisk Way. We are also trying to get 30 mph flashing notices along Golf Green Road

Thanks must go to Barry Shimell for his beach cleaning work and also to Mrs McGuire in Brooklands. There are various beach clean events through the year organised by Jackie Barter but these 2 are doing regularly most days.

A date for your diary, 18th July 2015 is the day of the Jaywick Summer Fayre and it's a 50's theme.

FY – explained the Winter Warmers and Jaywick Bereavement and Friendship club projects.

BO – we have a problem trying to get grants for work on the church, though we have received one donation.

2 dates for your diary 6th Dec – Messy Church at St James's and 7th Dec - Carols at Golf Green Hall.

TC (Tendring District Council) the land development is still ongoing and the purchase of some of the land is in its final stages. We are still looking for vacant sites that are for sale. They also are doing soil samples to see what is required to meet building regs. The maybe a Housing Association set up for the houses by Tendring District Council – the houses are planned to go to those in need in the Tendring area only.

RH asked about Tudor Fields – nothing known

JJ – coffee morning run by the offending team is still ongoing.

Ice energy have left the area but will return IF they get further funding for the area.

Motor cycle problems along promenade – passed to the Wardens.
